LA R.S. 12:1173 requires the applicant to designate the supervising professional architect who shall perform all professional architectural services or who shall directly supervise the performance of all architectural services by said corporation, and further designate the supervising professional engineer who shall perform all professional civil, mechanical or electrical engineering which the State Board of Registration of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors and the State Board of Architectural Examiners may jointly specify, or who shall directly supervise the performance of all such engineering services by said corporation. Said statute further provides that persons designated must be full-time active employees of the corporation and whose primary occupation is with that corporation.
